

Front-End Development

Once the graphic compositions are approved, Americaneagle.com moves into front-end development to produce the website's templates and establish the site's styles, interactions, performance, and accessibility. Americaneagle.com follows industry best practices for front-end development, utilizing the latest well-tested and supported languages and approaches to create functional, efficient, and innovative websites.

Approach

Mobile Up: Americaneagle.com takes a "mobile up" approach to development. Determining what will be the best interface in small screens usually scales well as the browser size increases. This approach prevents sites from becoming overly complex or overly simple in a way that would degrade the user experience on one device or another. Rather, it allows for a site experience that considers all devices and the impacts to the user.

Responsive Design: Americaneagle.com utilizes a fluid responsive grid framework to ensure the website will be viewable in screen sizes from mobile phones to desktop monitors. Prior to launch of the website, Americaneagle.com will provide an audit, detailing the website's compliance standing and any relevant supporting details. This audit document, which requires Client signature prior to

launch, is provided to assist with your preparedness for website accessibility and help serve as a roadmap for relevant future business and content decisions, as well as ongoing support. Testing & Training

Testing

A series of tests are conducted by Americaneagle.com for every web application. These tests come in several phases, but can also be performed concurrently:

The programmer(s) that created the site and then the project manager perform tests. These tests verify that each of the site's main functions works correctly, that all aspects of the project plan have been implemented and function correctly, and that all areas of the site are finalized. For standard processes and best practices, our programmers perform the following:

- **Code Reviews:** A senior level developer reviews the programming for architectural and security flaws. They confirm code adheres to our security standards and also ensure the code is optimized and performs as expected.
- Security Vulnerability: We run security scans using 3rd party software that test the website against known security vulnerabilities, such as SQL Injection and Cross Site Scripting and remedy all issues before going live.

The Quality Control team reviews the site. The quality control team uses a customized test plan to test each field and function of the site looking for bugs, errors, broken links, and missing or incorrect information. After the reported issues are fixed, each issue is retested by the QC team for final verification. Specifically, several different types of testing are used:

- **HTML & Design Review:** This type of testing involves comparing the approved graphic designs to the HTML templates and completed front end.
- **Cross Browser:** This is a process to test web applications across multiple browsers to ensure compatibility.
- **Functional:** This includes test cases based on the specifications for each component and is typically based on the requirements documentation. These tests also confirm which conversions can be completed.
- **CMS:** This type of test focuses on the back end of the website. The project manager will provide the QC team with further direction based on the project's needs.
- **Responsive / Device / Mobile:** This includes testing across different devices and different screen sizes to make sure the front end functions as expected.
- **Regression:** This is a type of software testing that seeks to uncover new software bugs, or regressions, in existing functional and non-functional areas of a system after changes such as enhancements, patches, or configuration changes have been made.

Training

This proposal includes 8 hours to be used towards training related to the project and the individual client's unique needs.

With this training budget, the Project Manager and client will work to determine how the hours should be used to best suit the client's needs. In developing the training plan, Project Managers will consider the ability levels of the user groups, the optimal timing for training, and the immediate goals for maintaining the website. The Project Manager can make best practices recommendations for how the hours are utilized.

The goal of the training is to equip the site administrators with the knowledge to successfully manage their website. Additionally, Americaneagle.com can continue to provide training as part of our client services maintenance program after the site is live.

Training hours can be used for:

Training Sessions

External Hosting

If RLDatix chooses to host the website internally and not host with Americaneagle.com, then upon completion of the project, which will be developed within the Americaneagle.com hosting environment, the full copy of the site, including the database, will be delivered via FTP or on CD / DVD disc. The project is considered fully completed upon delivery of the full copy of the website and database to RLDatix. Furthermore, RLDatix is responsible for the costs of any additional hardware and/or software needed to run the website or database. Americaneagle.com will supply RLDatix with a list of software, if requested. Americaneagle.com does not use any proprietary software and all software that may be needed is commonly found on a site such as www.cdw.com. Americaneagle.com is not responsible for the set-up of the hosting environment or the deployment of the site within that hosting environment. Should RLDatix need any set-up assistance, additional time can be billed separately as necessary.

On Premise Hosting:

For development of the website, Americaneagle.com will use Microsoft SQL Server 2017, unless otherwise specified below or as defined in project planning documents. After development work has started, downgrading a database to an older SQL edition (e.g. 2016 to 2008 R2) is not recommended, nor officially supported and will require additional fees on a time and materials basis (in cases where a downgrade is possible).

Launch Support

Americaneagle.com can provide RLDatix with launch support, including migration of the site from Americaneagle.com's development site to RLDatix's servers. Americaneagle.com's external hosting support services include the following: remote into RLDatix servers, coach RLDatix through the set up on the phone, reply to emails about issues, and inspect files via screen sharing. This external hosting and launch support service is estimated at ten (10) hours of support.

Environment Setup Assumptions

- 1. Americaneagle.com assumes the client has qualified staff members with availability and proper access to production servers to perform or help americaneagle.com perform all the necessary tasks related to live deployments.
- 2. Americaneagle.com assumes the client has proper backup/restore procedures in place for all databases and source code on the production servers.
- 3. Americaneagle.com assumes that the client has proper procedures for maintaining hardware and software on the productions servers including installation of security patches on a strict schedule.
- 4. Americaneagle.com assumes the client has proper performance monitoring tools available on the production servers.

General Expectations & Assumptions

Browser Compatibility
